

Wild Flower:

A few times a year, City Park fields bloom with wildflowers. The cosmos flowers are orange, pink, white, and purple. The Park is full of color and both people and bees love them.

What you need: Paper towel roll or toilet paper rolls, Stapler or glue, Scissors, Paint

Directions:

1. Hold the paper towel roll up right and cut stripes horizontally about a half inch apart (they don't have to be precise).
2. Flatten all circles so they become egg shaped with the top and bottom parts flat.
3. Begin to staple or glue flatten edges together to make a flower shape.
4. You can stop at one flower or continue to add more flatten circles between others making the flower larger and larger.
5. Paint if desired.
