

City Park Frog:

City Park is full of frogs in its 11 miles of lagoons. You may not be able to always see them but if you close your eyes, you can hear them make a symphony of music especially at sunrise and sunset.

What you need to make 2 frogs: A yard of string, A toilet paper roll, Stapler, Scissors, Green paint, White paint, Red paint, Black marker, Construction paper

Directions:

1. Cut the toilet paper roll in half.
2. Cut the yard of string in half and tie knots on either end of the string.
3. Put the string in one end then staple down with the knot hanging out slightly. (Don't staple down the string).
4. Paint the roll green. Add some white paint to some of the green paint to make a lighter green to use for the spots.
5. Cut out and paint 4 legs.
6. Attach all four legs.
7. Draw, cut out, and attached the fly to the other end of the string.
8. Paint the inside of the mouth red and eyes on the frog.
9. Repeat to make the second frog.

How to use: Pull the knotted end of the string so the fly goes in the frog's mouth. Pull it back and repeat.
