

## Botanical Garden Butterfly:

Everyone loves to spend time in the New Orleans Botanical Garden Butterfly Garden. Did you know October is butterfly month? Keep your eyes peeled in the early autumn month for the many types of butterflies all around the Park who have been growing all spring in their chrysalises. In the meantime, make your own colorful butterflies at home.

What you need to make one butterfly: A toilet paper roll, Glue, Scissors, Colored paints, Googly eyes, Pipe cleaner, Black marker, Glitter and/or pompoms

### Directions:

1. Cut construction paper to fit around roll and glue it on.
2. Take another piece of construction paper, fold in half, draw a letter B, then cut it out. These are the wings.
3. Decorate the wings, add a mouth on the roll, and glue on the eyes on the roll (draw on eyes if you don't have googly eyes).
4. Glue the wings on the roll.
5. Take the pipe cleaner, fold in half, curl the edges, and glue to the top inside of the roll.
